Tour Description:

This 13 Days Northern Philippines Eco-Adventure Tour will require Sharp Travellers enough energy, power, and endurance. It will cover the most popular provinces in Northern Philippines wherein tourists will have a great view of the Philippines' countryside, mountain ranges, historical landmarks, cultural heritage, beaches, and local gourmet. Just the same, they will get a chance to immerse themselves to the one of the oldest indigenous tribe in the country.

Travel Tips:

- This is ideal for travellers with age ranges from 60 year old and below and physically fit.
- Hiking gears, sunglasses, caps, flash lights, cameras, sun block lotions, rubber shoes, crocs, light shirts and shorts are advisable to bring
- Adventurous and willing to explore new things and place
- This tour can be done from September to May of the year

Itinerary:

Day 01 – Arrive Manila. Meet & greet, transfer to hotel. Overnight in Manila

Day 02 – Morning departure to Banaue, an eight hour drive from Manila. The site of the world famous Banaue Rice Terraces, the eight wonder of the world, a 2000 year old Terraces that we're carved into the mountains of Ifugao by the ancestors of the indigenous people. Arrive Banaue late afternoon. Overnight at hotel.

Day 03 –Tour of Banaue Viewpoint & Bangaan Village. Back to Banaue hotel in the afternoon. At leisure. Overnight at hotel.

Day 04 – Morning departure to Sagada. Sagada is famous for the hanging tribal coffins wedged among the rocks in the forests. Tour of Sagada & Bontoc Musuem, which houses a varied collection of authentic artifacts and photos of mountain tribes. Overnight at guest inn.

Day 05 – Departure from Sagada to Baguio, a 6 hour drive. Baguio’s cool climate and pine clad hills have consistently lured visitors. The city serves as a Summer getaway from the crowds and heat of Manila. Baguio seduces with clean parks, lovely gardens, quaint churches and luscious vegetables. Overnight at hotel.

Day 06 – Baguio city tour include visits to Burnham Park, Camp John Hay, Baguio Cathedral, Mine’s View Park, Phil.Military Academy, Lourdes Grotto. Overnight at hotel.

Day 07 – Baguio to Vigan(travel time 5 hours). Vigan is a world heritage site, the provincial capital of Ilocos Sur. One of the few Hispanic towns left in the Philippines, and is well known for its cobblestone streets, and a unique architecture that fuses Philippine and Oriental building designs and construction, with colonial European architecture. Overnight at hotel.

Day 08 – Halfday Vigan tour include visits to Padre Burgos Musuem, Plaza Salcedo, Plaza Burgos, Pagburnayan, St. Paul Cathedral. Proceed to Laoag City, a 2 hours drive from Vigan. Laoag is a 1st class city & the capital in the province of Ilocos Norte, it’s the province’s political, commercial, and industrial hub. Overnight at hotel.

Day 09 – Laoag City tour include visits to St.Williams Cathedral, Batac City, Malacanang of the North, Marcos Musuem and Mausoleum, Paoay church, Sinking Bell Tower, Ilocos Norte capitol, Tabacalera. Overhight at hotel.

Day 10 – Departure for Pagudpud, a coastal resort town of Ilocos Norte province, Its white-sand beaches and crystal-blue water makes Pagudpud a haven for tourists. Maira-Ira Point is also an emerging attraction with its secluded beach known as the Blue Lagoon, as well as kilometer-long Saud Beach. Tour include visits to Cape Bojeador Lighthouse, Bangui Windmills, Kapurpurawan, Sta.Monica church, ruins & museums. Overnight at hotel.

Day 11 – At leisure in Pagudpud. Overnight at resort.

Day 12 – Pagudpud to Manila. Overnight Manila

Day 13 – Transfer to airport for onward destination.

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
